Our members range from novices to artists who have gained recognition working in oil, watercolor, pastel, pencil, ink, acrylic, photography, and sculpture.

The BAA meets on the third Thursday of the month, at the Bethlehem Public Library. Meetings begin at 6:45 and end by 9:00 p.m. The meetings are open to the public. During the year, our meetings feature any or all of the following:

- Demonstrations by local artists
- Critiques of members' works.
- Lectures
- Slide presentations
- A holiday party

We hold two art shows each year at the library — a judged show in November and an open, juried show in May. Prizes and ribbons are awarded in various categories.

We also offer two workshops yearly, usually on a Saturday.

Members exhibit their works on a rotating basis at several local venues available to the BAA, and they can participate in BAA sponsored outdoor art fairs. Occasionally, our members are called upon to help at community functions, sharing their expertise.

The BAA also provides scholarships to Bethlehem High School students.
